Pupil Premium Policy and Online Statement



The strong Christian ethos of our school underlines all that we do to support learners within St John's Walworth.

Key priorities:

- Our core aim for the use of Pupil Premium funding is to raise the attainment and progress of pupils eligible for pupil premium funding so that their performance compares favourably with Non-Pupil Premium peers.
- To address inequalities in the educational opportunities of pupils from low-income families and raise attainment of these pupils.
- To ensure that Looked After Children (children who are in the care of local authorities as defined by section 22 of the Children Act 1989) are not disadvantaged in any way with regard to their educational attainment and progress.

Expectations: Outstanding teaching and learning is paramount to the progress of pupils from potentially disadvantaged backgrounds.

This remains a consistent and rigorous focus. In addition to this, targeted intervention and support strategies are deployed in order to:

- improve levels of attainment and progress;
- close attainment gaps relative to performance of non-pupil premium pupils within the school;
- enhance reading, writing, mathematics and communication skills;
- engage and develop learning through comprehensive extra-curricular provision;
- have a clear focus on all disadvantaged pupils, including those with SEND and more able pupils
- support pupils in becoming aspirational, confident and successful learners within a Christian setting
- To prepare pupils for a successful secondary school experience by using national attainment markers to drive forward progress

Reporting: As well as the online statement which is available for all to read who have internet access the report is available in hard copy from the school office on request. Pupil Premium is a standing agenda item for governors' committee meetings, and is reported on termly in the Headteacher's Written Report to the full governing body meetings. Teachers and support staff report progress of Pupil Premium children at pupil progress meetings with the Senior Leadership Team at least once a term
